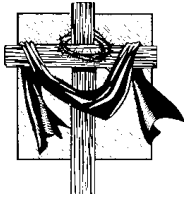

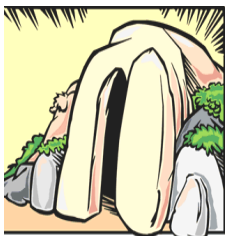

From the Messenger, April 12, 1942:

34 New Members received Holy Week, bringing our membership to 972 on the one hundred tenth anniversary of the founding of our Church (1832-1942). A reception for new members received since last November will be held Wednesday, April 15, at 7:30. This is your opportunity to meet them, greet them, and make them feel at home. Everybody come. Program and refreshments.
