From the Messenger, July 26, 1942:

Survey of Books will be taken by the young people Sunday, July 26th. Everyone is asked to bring to Sunday School a slip of paper with the names of the three books you would take with you if cast on a desert island.

From the Messenger, July 6, 1952:

On Sunday, July 13, Chaplain George S. Wilson will be on a short leave and will be in Salem and preach for us. There will be baptism of infants; anyone wishing to have their children baptized, call the church office, 3220. Holy Communion service will be observed.

From the Messenger, July 26, 1962:

Son of Congregation to Preach Sunday

Rev. William J. Weber, Assistant Pastor of the First Presbyterian Church, Ardmore, Pennsylvania, will preach at both services next Sunday morning. Mr. Weber and his family are currently visiting his parents, Mr. and Mrs. William Weber, at Sevokeen Lake.

According to church records, only three individuals have gone out from First Church Salem into full time Christian vocation. Many years ago, a missionary overseas was sent out from our Congregation. In recent years, two men have entered the gospel ministry, Lt. Jerry Rice is currently serving in the Air Force Chaplaincy in Alaska, and Mr. Weber has served in Philadelphia Presbytery since his ordination. Mr. Weber took his undergraduate work at the College of the Ozarks, Clarksville, Arkansas, one of our Presbyterian Colleges, and received his Bachelor of Divinity Degree from Princeton Seminary, New Jersey.

We welcome Mr. Weber to the pulpit and parish!
