## IMPORTANT NOTICE

In an effort to provide better security for our church building and the people in it, we are in the process of installing a professionally-monitored security system. We expect that the installation process will be completed on Monday, March 22 and be operative as soon as possible.

**It is very important that you do not try to enter the building with your key until you have been trained and given an access code.** The keypads for entering the access codes will be located at the west (Kitchen) door and at the north door of the building. Entering the building *without* an access code will result in an alarm and the summoning of the police, and obviously we want to prevent "false alarms".
